44. PLANNING APPLICATIONS – The following planning applications were considered;

WD/2016/1931/F - Mount Pleasant Cottage, Chalvington Road. – Change of use of previously approved garage into a granny annexe – Chalvington with Ripe has no objections to this application on any planning grounds as long as the granny annexe is ancillary to the main house.

WD2016/1899/F - Mulbarton, Poundfield Road - Conservatory consisting of half brick, half glazed, brickwork will be cavity type with insulation. Windows and doors double glazed UPVC. Lean to roof constructed of timber with sheets of marine ply and felt shingle - Chalvington with Ripe has no objections to this application on any planning grounds.

46. DEFIBRILLATORS – The Clerk has asked the Shop Manager for permission to put a defibrillator on the outside wall of the shop. The request will be put to the shop's committee.
