107. REPORT FROM CHAIRMAN ON PARISHES LANDRAISE CO-ORDINATION

PUBLIC ADJOURNMENT -

D Cllr Watkins reported that the Special Charge for Closed Churchyards is being temporarily withdrawn. Pelham Builders are going for a judicial review of the Core Strategy. The Oakfield Bungalow Planning Application has been approved by Wealden because they felt it is in keeping with the surrounding agricultural buildings and the roof can not be seen from the road.

Cllr Webb entered the meeting.

C Cllr Bennett reported that the ring fencing of some money in Adult Social Care has been removed and he asked Councillors to report any local flood issues to him or via the ESCC website.

C Cllr Bennett invited those present to the Annual Construction Industry Event on 8th February. This is a drive to get government involved in local businesses.

C Cllr Bennett left the meeting.

108. ACTIONS REQUIRED BY PARISH COUNCIL: None.

WD2010/2799F – Newhouse Farm, Chalvington Road – Lean to extension to barn – We have no objections to this application.

WD2011/0008F – Curls Farm Barn, Ripe Road – Erection of dwelling on site of disused agricultural barn – Chalvington with Ripe Parish council has previously opposed development on this site because it would affect the setting of the conservation area and a number of listed properties, and because the barn itself does not merit conversion in order to save it from falling into disrepair. The Village Plan identifies a need for affordable housing and a children's play area in the village, and in the council's view this would be a better use of the site. However, the council might be able to support this proposal if a piece of land for a play area were provided as part of the application - this might be immediately to the North of the proposed new entrance.

WD2010/2847F – Broomham Farm, Whitesmith – Solar PV (Photovoltaic) ground mounted array – We have no objections to this application.

110. REPORT ON PLANNING DECISIONS TAKEN BY WDC.

WD2010/2459F – **Hampton Court, The Street, Ripe** – First floor extension to rear of property and enlargement of rear dormer window – REFUSED.
